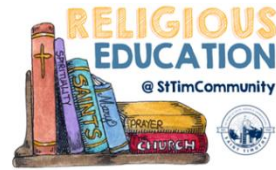
The Religious Education program exists to support the parents, as first catechists, to raise their children in the faith. The Mass is central to our beliefs, therefore consistent participation in weekly Mass is of great importance.

When children attend Mass with the family, the connection between Liturgy and religious education classes are more fully understood. As part of our program, children need to attend Mass every Sunday (or Saturday evening) and reflect on the liturgy using their Mass Journal.

- Every Sunday (or Saturday evening) attend Mass at St. Timothy or another Catholic parish.
- Complete a Journal entry by selecting one of the following:
 - Use the Journal page provided to write a brief summary about what they learned from the Gospel.
 - Read and complete “The Kid’s Bulletin” section from the Bulletin provided at Mass at St. Timothy.
- The Journal will be checked weekly by the catechist in class.
