

Baptisms at St. Timothy

Thank you for your interest in baptizing your child at St. Timothy Catholic Church. Attached you will find information, requirements, and application for Baptism. Kindly read the entire packet. Once you have obtained all the necessary documents, contact the parish office to schedule an appointment to turn in your documents, donation, and select the date for your child's Baptism. The date of the Baptism is dependent on a complete application. Feel free to contact the office for any questions or guidance as needed.

PRIVATE BAPTISMS / BAUTIZOS PRIVADOS

Private Baptisms are celebrated on most Saturdays at 9:00 AM, 10:00 AM, 1:00 PM, 2:00 PM, and 3:00 PM. An anticipated donation of \$300 is requested. Parents and godparents need to arrive 15 minutes prior to the ceremony.

COMMUNAL BAPTISMS / BAUTIZOS COMUNITARIOS

Communal Baptisms are celebrated at 2:00PM: Every 2nd Sunday of the month in Spanish Every 4th Sunday of the month in English Parents and godparents need to arrive 15 minutes prior to the ceremony. An anticipated donation of \$100 is requested.

PRE-BAPTISMAL CLASSES / CLASES PRE-BAUTISMAL

Parents and godparents are required to attend a Pre-Baptismal Class. Classes are held at St. Timothy in English once monthly and in Spanish once monthly on Saturdays at 9:00AM in LaCerra B Hall. Contact the parish office to find the next available date and register for the class. Pre-registration is required.

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Baptism Requirements



- Both parents must request the Sacrament of Baptism for their child by signing the Baptism Application and the Baptism Requirements forms.
- **Parents** At least one parent <u>must be baptized Catholic</u> and commit themselves to teaching the faith to their child. They must present the following documents:
 - Child's *Birth Certificate*
 - If parents are divorced or separated, they need to sign and complete the *Rights and responsibilities of Parents and Guardians of Students in Parish Faith Formation Programs Form*
 - If parents are not parishioners of St. Timothy, they need to present a *Permission Letter Live Out of Boundaries Permission* from their parish granting permission for the child to be baptized at St. Timothy.
- <u>Godparents</u> are selected by the parents to assist them in the preparation for the sacrament and helping the child fulfill the baptismal promises by helping the child grow in the faith. There should be two godparents, one male and one female godparent (or just one).

It is understood that the parents will select godparents who:

- Lead a life of faith in harmony with the role to be undertaken and are active in a Catholic parish
- Is older than 16 years of age
- Has received the three Catholic Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation
- Is living their Christian vocation as a single person, or as a validly married person (married in the Catholic Church)

The parents must turn in the following documents for each godparent:

- **Sponsor letter** (from Catholic Parish where they practice their faith and signature of the pastor providing permission for them to be a Baptism sponsor)
- \circ $\;$ If there is no sponsor letter, then submit the following documents:
 - Baptism Certificate
 - Confirmation Certificate
 - Catholic marriage certificate (If married, must be in Catholic faith)
- Parents and godparents must attend a Baptism Preparation Class

The godparents must provide proof that they have received the Sacraments of Initiation and must lead a life of faith in harmony with the role to be undertaken.



Baptism Sponsor Letter

BAPTISM SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS

This form is to be filled out and signed by the sponsor and the sponsor's Pastor and have the seal of the parish.

- I. Insofar as possible, a person to be baptized is to be given a sponsor who assists an adult in Christian initiation or together with the parents presents an infant for baptism. A sponsor also helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it. (Can. 872)
- II. There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor or one of each. (Can. 873)
- III. 1. To be permitted to take on the function of sponsor a person must:
 - 1. be designated by the one to be baptized, by the parents or the person who takes their place, or in their absence by the pastor or minister and have the aptitude and intention of fulfilling this function
 - 2. be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on;
 - 3. not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared;
 - 4. not be the father or mother of the one to be baptized.

2. A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community is not to participate except together with a Catholic sponsor and then only as a witness of the baptism. (Can. 874)
